Guidelines for Parents

(As per the Code of Ethics & Good practice for Young Players, available on www.ladiesgaelic.ie)

Ladies Gaelic Football association believes that parents should:

1. Be a role model for your child and maintain the highest standards of conduct when interacting with children, other parents, officials and organizers.
2. Always behave responsibly and do not seek to unfairly affect the game or a player.
3. Never intentionally expose and young players to embarrassments or disparagement by the use of flippant or sarcastic remarks.
4. Always recognise the value and importance of volunteers who provide sporting recreational opportunities for your child. Do not publicly question the judgement or honesty of referees, coaches or organisers. Respect referees, coaches, organisers and other players.
5. Encourage your child to play by the rules. Teach your child that honest endeavour is as important as winning and do all you can to encourage good sportsmanship.
6. Set a good example by applauding good play on both sides. Encourage mutual respect for team-mates and opponents.
7. Parents should support all efforts to remove abusive behaviour and bullying behaviour in all its forms.
8. Read the Anti bullying policy within the Club organisation.
9. Sign up to the Code of Ethics & Good practice for Young Players in Ladies Gaelic Football.
10. Ensure that your child's club has adopted and implemented the Code of Ethics & Good practice for Young Players.
11. Know the start and finish times of training and ensure that you arrive at the end of training.
12. Volunteer to assist with training – Help with equipment, in dressing rooms at games and when travelling to games.

Parents code of Conduct

1. I will respect the rules and procedures set down in the Ladies Gaelic Football Association Code of Ethics and Good Practice for Children in Sport
2. I will respect my child's team mate, mentors (e.g. Managers, Coaches, and Selectors) and parents, as well as players, parents and coaches from opposing teams. I will encourage my child to treat other players, coaches, selectors and managers with respect.
3. I will give encouragement and applaud positive accomplishments whether from my child or her teams mates, their opponents or the officials.
4. I will respect all officials and their authority during matches.
5. I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behaviour or use foul language.
