


U21 Football

Our U21 football Squad won the city championship at the weekend with a deserved win over Kildimo-Pallaskenry on a scoreline of 5-5 to 0-9.

Taking early control in the half-back line and midfield, they created a number of scoring chances and put three points on the board before their opponents replied with their first score. They extended the lead when a fine team move ended with Brian Barry hitting the net for the first goal. Shortly afterwards Sean Mullane made the first of a number of fine saves to deny Kildimo-Pallaskenry a way back into the match. Mungret St Pauls took full advantage of this turning a sustained run of possession into a score of two goals and two points for a lead of 3-5 to 0-1 at the 25th minute, with the goals coming from Sean Moran and Brian Barry at the end of some fine passing moves.

The complexion of the game then turned against us as the team was reduced to 14 men and faced into the second half a man down and playing against a strengthening wind which was blowing diagonally across the pitch. The lineout was reshuffled to face the elements, knowing that they needed to keep the scoreboard ticking over and avoid conceding goals. They hit two further goals through Brian Considine and Adam Storan, but did waste quite a number of point-scoring opportunities. However the last line of defence stood firm conceding no goals under pressure, good defensive work and a couple of fine saves by Sean Mullane enabled a 5 goal lead with 10 minutes to play. As the evening darkened and more rain fell, the match drew to a close with Mungret St Pauls winning by 11 points.

This was a fine team performance, notable for high quality scoring moves in difficult playing conditions, good defensive work near our own goal and an honest attitude and workrate from all 21 players used on the day. We will face the east champions, Pallasgreen, for a place in the county final in Kilbreedy at 12noon on Sunday 6th December.
